

CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE WITH THE EUROPEAN COSMETICS REGULATION

The European Cosmetics Regulation entered into force on 11 January 2010. It is applicable in its entirety from 11 July 2013 and finally replaces the European Cosmetics Directive 2008/42/CE

Since Mars 2005 (directive 2003/15/EC), the allergens substances must be indicated in the list of ingredients when their concentration exceed 0.001% in leave-on products or 0.01% in rinse-off products.

Restrictions (Maximal percentage of use - Theoretical value) :

- 40% of fragrance in Fine Fragrance
- 40% of fragrance in Eau de toilette
- 40% of fragrance in Solid Perfume
- 40% of fragrance in Rinse-off
- 40% of fragrance in Other leave-on
- 3.98% of fragrance in Solar product
- 40.02% of fragrance in Oral care product*

Please note that Commission Regulation (EU) 2017/1410 of 2 August 2017 amending Annexes II and III to Regulation (EC) No 1223/2009 of the European Parliament and of the Council on cosmetic products has been published in the Official Journal of August 3rd, 2017 for the three substances listed below:

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HICC (Hydroxyisohexyl 3-cyclohexene carboxaldehyde) CAS #31906-04-4
2,6-Dihydroxy-4-methyl-benzaldehyde (atranol) CAS#526-37-4
3-Chloro-2,6- Dihydroxy-4-methyl-benzaldehyde (chloroatranol) CAS#57074-21-2

The transitional periods are the following:

- From 23 August 2019, cosmetic products containing one or more of these substances shall not be placed on the European Union market.
- From 23 August 2021, cosmetic products containing one or more of these substances shall not be made available on the Union market.

As regards ATRANOL CAS # 526-37-4 & CHLOROATRANOL CAS # 57074-21-2, the manufacturer does not use these substances as such.

These substances are contained in OAKMOSS and TREEMOSS and we confirm that the quality of our raw materials complies with the Cosmetic Regulation 1223/2009 and IFRA standards.
